

# 2020 MIPS Targeted Review Deadline October 1st

## August 17, 2021

Practitioners who participated in 2020 MIPS can now review their payment adjustment factor(s) on the [\*\*Quality Payment Program website\*\*](#). Your final score will dictate the payment adjustment you will receive in 2022, with a positive, negative, or neutral payment adjustment being applied to the Medicare paid amount for covered professional services furnished by a MIPS eligible clinician in 2022. If you believe an error has been made in your MIPS payment adjustment factor(s) calculation, you can submit a targeted review until 8 p.m. EST, on October 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Examples of targeted review circumstances:**

- ⇒ Errors or data quality issues for measures and activities you submitted
- ⇒ Data submitted under wrong Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) or National Provider Identifier (NPI)
- ⇒ Eligibility and special status issues (e.g., you fall below the low-volume threshold and should not have received a payment adjustment)
- ⇒ Being erroneously excluded from the APM participation list and not being scored under the APM Scoring Standard
- ⇒ Performance categories were not automatically reweighted even though you qualify for automatic reweighting due to extreme and uncontrollable circumstances

Additionally, CMS may require documentation to support a targeted review request that is under its evaluation.
