

CIGNA-Reimbursement Policy Update Regarding E&M Codes Billed with Modifier 25 and Minor Procedures Effective August 13, 2022

May 25, 2022

As a result of a recent review, CIGNA will require the submission of office notes with claims submitted with evaluation and management (E&M) codes **99212, 99213, 99214, and 99215 and modifier 25 when a minor procedure is billed.**

The E&M line will be denied if they do not receive documentation that supports that a significant and separately identifiable service was performed. Denials will include administrative appeal rights. **This update is effective for claims processed on or after August 13, 2022.** Please note that the requirement to submit documentation only applies to claims that include one or more office-based minor procedures.

If you have not yet received a letter from Cigna informing you of this update, you will probably be receiving it soon.

Cigna will update the Modifier 25-Significant, Separately Identifiable Evaluation and Management Service by the Same Physician on the Same Day of the Procedure or Other Service reimbursement policy to reflect this change.
